Luis Filipe was born in Coimbra, Portugal, in December 1953. He qualified from the University of Coimbra in 1977

- In 1989, he undertook Fellowship of the National Health Service (SNS) and has been admitted as Specialist of General Surgery in Hospital São Teotónio (HST), in Viseu
- In 1996, he became Senior Consultant in General Surgery
- From 1997 to 2000, he led the Education Department of the HST
- In 1999, he undertook the Advanced Trauma Life Support (ATLS, ACS) Student and Instructor Courses in Lisbon. He is Regional Director and member of the National ATLS Committee since 2004
- In 2000, he became Chief of the General Surgery Service
- He undertook the Definitive Surgical Trauma Care (DSTC) course, in Porto, in 2005. He integrated the Faculty of the DSTC course in Porto and Coimbra in 2006, Coimbra 2007, Lisbon 2008, Coimbra 2009 and Madeira 2010.
- He is the President of the General Assembly of Lusitanian Association of Trauma and Emergency Surgery (Associação Lusitana de Trauma e Emergência Cirúrgica, ALTEC), since 2005
- Member of the Vascular Committee of the Portuguese Society of Surgery
- Member of ISS/SIC and IATSIC since 2008
- Portuguese Delegate in ESTES (European Society for Trauma and Emergency Surgery since 2009
- Director of Surgery 1 Service of Hospital São Teotónio in Viseu since 2009
