#### Course Format

CCrISP is an interactive course that combines a variety of teaching and learning techniques, such as simulated patient scenarios, case-based skill stations and demonstrations. You will be encouraged to share knowledge and experience with your peers throughout the course.

### Assessment

- Formative pre-course MCQ:

## **Participants**

- Participants must have done at least two years of training after finishing medical school, including at least six months in a surgical post.
- Participants in their first two years after medical school (internships) are not eligible to attend.
