Henrique Miguel Marques Bom Borges Alexandrino was born in Coimbra, Portugal, in 1975

- He qualified from the University of Coimbra in 1999
- In 2000 he was admitted as an Intern in the Coimbra University Hospital (Hospitais da Universidade de Coimbra, HUC)
- In 2002 he began training as a Resident in General Surgery in the Coimbra University Hospital (Hospitais da Universidade de Coimbra, HUC), concluding the Residency in July 2008
- In 2002 he undertook the Advanced Trauma Life Support (ATLS, ACS) Student and Instructor Courses, in Coimbra and Lisbon, respectively and has since participated as Instructor in over 20 ATLS courses. He was Course Director in the 14<sup>th</sup>, 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> ATLS Courses in Coimbra.
- In December 2005 he, with others, founded the Lusitanian Association of Trauma and Emergency Surgery (Associação Lusitana de Trauma e Emergência Cirúrgica, ALTEC), in which he now serves as member of the board
- He is since October 2006 Assistant Professor of Clinical Surgery in the Coimbra University Medical School (Faculdade de Medicina da Universidade de Coimbra, FMUC)
- He undertook the Definitive Surgical Trauma Care (DSTC, IATSIC) course in Coimbra in November 2006 and served as instructor in the DSTC courses in 2008, 2009 and 2011
- As part of his interest on Acute Care Surgery he did a fellowship on Trauma and Emergency Surgery in the Meilahti Hospital, in Helsinki, Finland in October 2008
- Between 2008 and June 2011 he participated as an active member in the Paediatric Liver Transplant Team in Coimbra
- He is a member of ISS and IATSIC since 2009 and is also a member of the Portuguese Society of Surgeons (Sociedade Portuguesa de Cirurgia)
- He has authored or co-authored 3 articles and has collaborated in the technical revision of the Portuguese translation of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Edition of the DSTC Course Manual
- He is currently undertaking the PhD program in Medical Sciences in Coimbra University Medical School (Faculdade de Medicina da Universidade de Coimbra, FMUC). His research interest are the study of liver regeneration and ischemia-reperfusion injury
